Residential Care Facilities, R3.1, Checklist

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS: (This is in addition to typical room addition or remodel requirements)

- Have Applicant fill out Residential Care Worksheet**
 - If applicant intends to house **any** non-ambulatory or bedridden clients **and** there is not a direct exit to the outside from each of their bedrooms, then the exiting plan must be designed by a licensed architect or engineer, as required by the City of Rocklin Building Official.
- Complete Building Permit Application**
- Plot plan showing location of home on the lot with any new addition area (if applicable).**
- Floor Plan of existing and any remodeled or new areas including:**
 - Use of rooms (i.e. bedrooms, common areas, kitchen, bathrooms, etc.)
 - Bedrooms labeled with number of clients and type of clients (i.e. ambulatory, non-ambulatory, or bedridden).
 - Size of doors and windows
 - Locate main exits
- Additions and/or remodels for existing RCF's need a copy of their 850 form**

Bedridden person means a person, requiring assistance in turning and repositioning in bed, or being unable to independently transfer to and from bed, except in facilities with appropriate and sufficient care staff, mechanical devices if necessary, and safety precautions as determined in Title 22 regulations, by the Director of Social Services or his or her designated representative. Per CRC Sec R202.
