STRATEGIC PLANNING ITEMS

The City Council and Executive Staff for the City of Rocklin is scheduled to meet in a strategic planning session. Strategic planning is an organizational management activity that is used to set priorities, focus energy and resources, strengthen operations, ensure that employees and other stakeholders are working toward common goals, establish agreement around intended outcomes/results, and assess and adjust the organization's direction in response to a changing environment.

The purpose of this meeting is to establish the framework for the City's Strategic Plan update. The Strategic Plan is one of the key tools for implementing the City's General Plan. The General Plan provides an overarching vision and sets policies for guiding the physical, economic, social and cultural development of the City over the next twenty years. In contrast the Strategic Plan looks at the next five years and outlines strategies, projects and programs that will support a phased implementation of the General Plan. As an outcome of this strategic planning session, Departmental Action Plans will be devised to take the Strategic Plan and break it down into shorter, more actionable units. Action Plans are developed and revised annually with no more than a two year implementation schedule. These Action Plans will drive budget and staff time allocations and drive budget preparation for FY 2017-2018.
