NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rocklin will hold a public hearing in the Council Chambers at the **Rocklin City Hall Building, 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin**, beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 29, 2016 to consider the following:

RE: CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER) FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2015 (2015-2016)

Project Description:

In accordance with a requirement of the federally-funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, city staff has prepared the annual CAPER. The CAPER contains information on performance and program accomplishments during the 2015-2016 CDBG program year. The report provides information regarding the City's expenditure of federal CDBG funds; specially addressing progress made by the City towards completion of public service activities, economic development, and accessibility projects. The 2014 CAPER has been completed in compliance with federal program regulations and the City's Citizen Participation Plan. The current CAPER covers the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 and is available for review and comment.

Availability of Documents:

The public review period for this document is 15 days prior to the hearing date, from November 3rd to November 18th. During this time, the public is invited to comment. Copies of the 2015 CAPER are available via hardcopy at the City's Housing Division Office located at 3980 Rocklin Rd. (Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.), and on the City's website at: <http://www.rocklin.ca.us>
The City of Rocklin must receive all written comments regarding the 2015 CAPER no later than November 25th, 2016 in order to include it before the CAPER submittal deadline.

Public Comments:

A Public Hearing will be held on November 29, 2016 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 3970 Rocklin Rd. Rocklin, California. All interested persons are invited to appear and be heard.

The City does not transcribe proceedings. Persons who wish to obtain a verbatim record should arrange for attendance by a court report or any other acceptable means of recordation. Such arrangements are at the sole expense of the person requesting the recordation.

If you challenge the decision of the City Council on this matter in court, the challenge may be limited to raising only those issues which you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to, the public hearing.

Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in the notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code §65009)
