Winners of each 2-D Category will be able to exhibit at the Rocklin Library Student Exhibit (April 1st – June 3rd). Award winning art and ribbon should be checked in with the Library Representative after the reception.

All entries should have a label on the back with artist's name, school, teacher and grade.
