ELECTION SUMMARY

DATE OF ELECTION

Tuesday, November 8, 2016. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This election will be consolidated with Placer County, who will print and mail the sample ballots, determine polling places and precinct officers, process absentee ballot applications, and conduct the tabulation (canvass) of the votes.

POSITIONS FOR ELECTION

City Council: Three seats have terms that expire in November, 2020 (4-year terms):

Councilmember Greg Janda (currently serving as Mayor)
Councilmember Dave Butler
Councilmember George Magnuson

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates must be 18 years of age, a Citizen of the United States, and a registered voter residing within the City limits.

NOMINATION PERIOD

Opens: Monday, July 18, 2016

Closes: Friday, August 12, 2016, unless an incumbent does not file, then the period is extended to Wednesday, August 17, 2016.

NOMINATION PAPERS AND / OR CANDIDATES GUIDE

Nomination papers will be available starting on the first day of the nomination period, Monday, July 18, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Pulling nomination papers will take approximately 30 minutes. All candidates are requested to make an appointment to pull nomination papers, by calling 625-5588.



COST

There is no cost to pull nomination papers.

Those candidates that choose to have a candidate statement printed in the sample ballot pay for the printing of that statement, which is estimated to be \$470.00.

Regular City Council meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month at 6:00 p.m. (closed sessions usually start at the end of the meeting). Special or adjourned City Council meetings may be held as needed.

Councilmembers are currently paid \$685.00 per month.

MAYOR

The Mayor is appointed every 12 months on a rotational basis by the City Council.
