This application is a request for approval of an extension of time for the following previously approved entitlements to allow the creation of the Villages at Civic Center subdivision:

- A Tentative Subdivision Map (SD-2004-08) to subdivide approximately 12.45 gross acres into 11 single family residential lots, 54 residential townhome lots, and 6 lots for circulation, recreational facilities, landscaping, and open space/conservation area.
- An Oak Tree Preservation Permit (TRE-2004-58) to allow the removal of up to 26 oak trees.

The subject property is made up of 7 parcels totaling approximately 12.45 gross acres generally located west of Ruhkala Road, east of Lost Avenue, and north of Evelyn Avenue. Assessor Parcel Numbers (APNs) 010-191-029, -032, -048, -049, -077 and 010-260-038 and -048.

The property is zoned Planned Development Residential eight dwelling units per acre and four dwelling units per acre (RD-4 and RD-8)). The General Plan designation is Medium Density Residential (MDR).

A Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impacts was previously approved for this project by the Rocklin City Council through Resolution No. 2005-306.

The applicant and property owner is Greg Judkins of Riverland Homes, Inc.
