**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the **CITY COUNCIL** of the City of Rocklin will hold a public hearing in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS at Rocklin City Hall**, 3970 Rocklin Road, beginning at **6:00 p.m.** on **TUESDAY, MARCH 12, 2024** to consider the following:

This project is a request for approval of a Conditional Use Permit (U2023-0005) and Design Review (DR2023-0011) to allow for the modification of an existing approximately 120-foot lattice cell tower located on the Placer County Water Agency (PCWA) property adjacent to Boulder Ridge Park. The project proposes to add 30 feet to the top of the tower, 12 new panel antennas (4 per sector) as well as additional ancillary equipment. The increased tower height is to achieve required separation between existing antennas and the proposed new antennas. All new ground mounted equipment would be within the existing approximately 300 square foot fenced in area at the base of the tower.

The project site is located at 3525 Park Drive. The Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) is 032-010-009.

The property is designated Public Quasi Public (PQP). The property is zoned Planned Development Public Quasi Public (PD-PQP).

A preliminary review of this project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) has tentatively identified a Categorical Exemption (ENV2023-0010) as the appropriate level of environmental review for this project.

The property owner is Placer County Water Agency. The applicant is New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, C/O Epic Wireless LLC; Attn. Mark Lobaugh.

The Planning Commission reviewed this item on February 6, 2024 and voted 5-0 to recommend City Council approval of the project.
