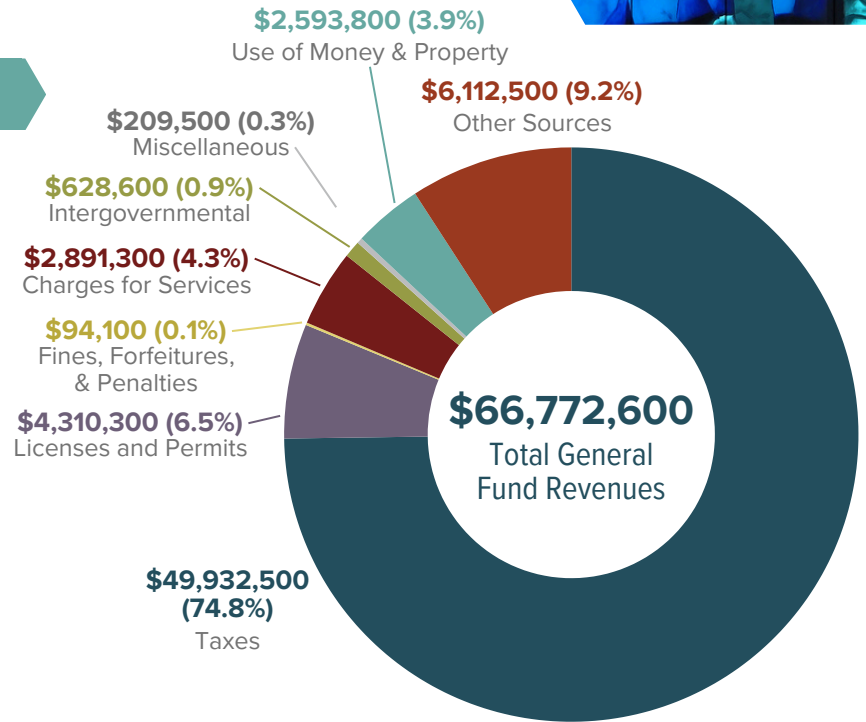
REVENUES BY CATEGORY

TAXES: Includes Franchise fees, Property taxes, Sales taxes, Transient Occupancy taxes.

LICENSES & PERMITS: Includes Building Permits, Dog Licenses, Land Use Permits.

CHARGES FOR SERVICES: Includes Business License Application Fees, Engineering Inspection/ Plan Checks, etc.

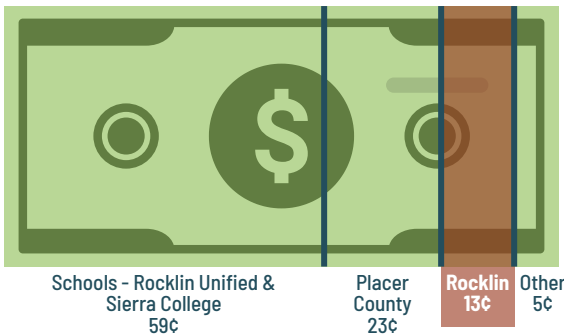
OTHER: Includes Use of Money and Property, Miscellaneous Revenue, Intergovernmental, Fines, Forfeitures & Penalties.



TAX BREAKDOWN

PROPERTY TAXES are assessed and collected by the counties; taxes go into a pool and are then allocated to the cities. Approximately **12.7%** of ad valorem property taxes levied in Rocklin go to the City. (That's about 13¢ from every dollar.)

Property Tax Revenue Budget: \$25,213,600



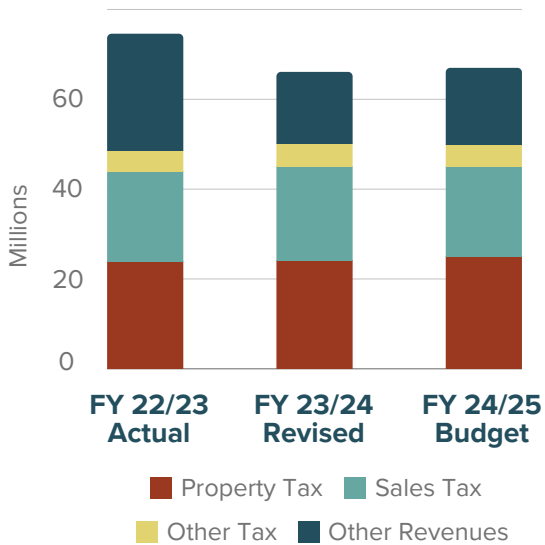
STATE SALES AND USE TAXES provide revenue to the state's General Fund, to cities and counties through specific state fund allocations, and to other local jurisdictions. The current sales tax rate of 7.25% is distributed to various agencies with **1.0%** going to the City of Rocklin and 6.25% going to other agencies.

Sales Tax Revenue Budget: \$20,024,200

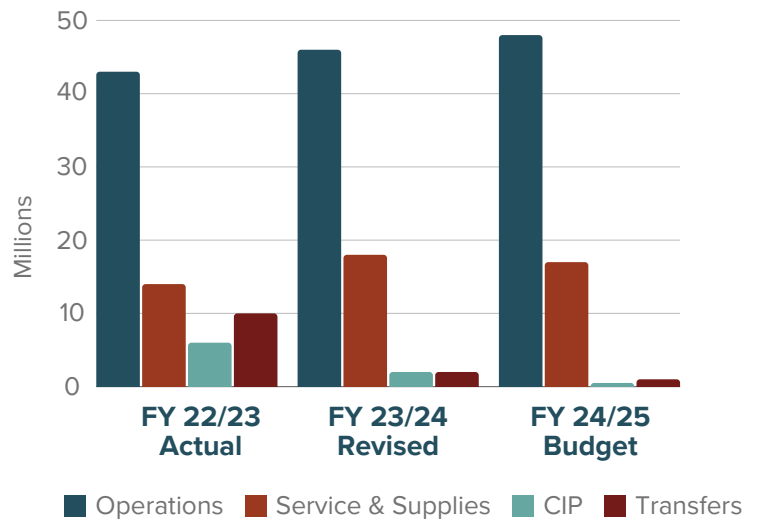

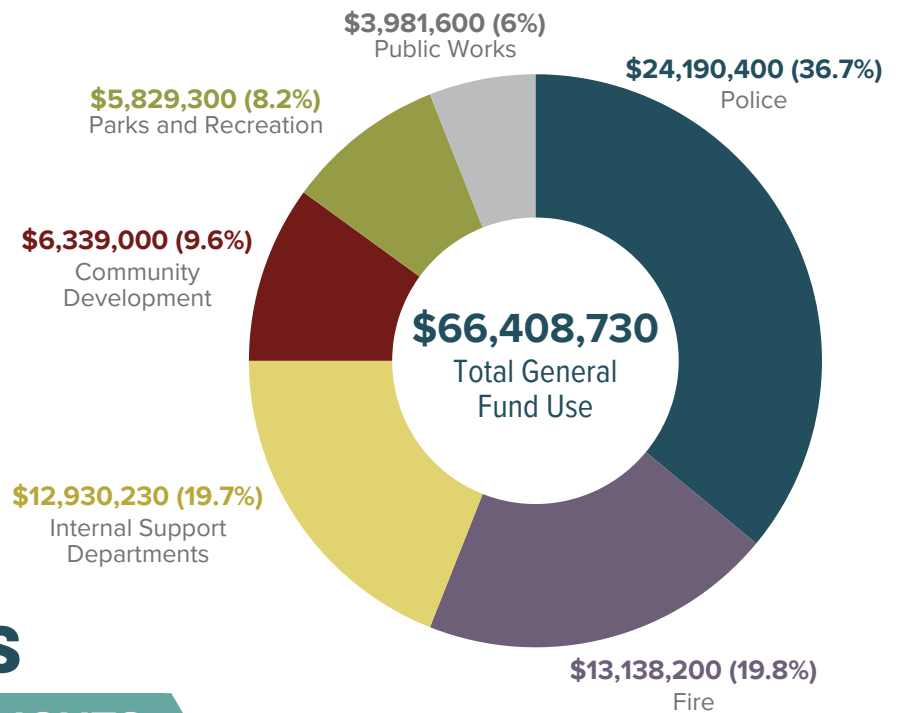


EXPENDITURES
